Opening a current account with us

Go to personal.natwest.com/personal/current-accounts/what-do-you-need-to-open-a-current-account.html to find out how you can open an account, and what information and documents you need to give us to open an account.

How quickly do we open personal current accounts?

We give customers an account number and enable them to start paying into the account:

the same day, for 0% of customers;

on average, in 1 day; and

within 1 day for 99% of customers

These figures are based on the time taken from our receiving all the information and documents we ask for at personal.natwest.com/personal/current-accounts/what-do-you-need-to-open-a-current-account.html, in a case where we don't need any further information or documents to open the account.

How quickly do we give customers a debit card?*

Once an account is open, we give customers a debit card:

the same day, for 0% of customers;

on average, in 3 days; and

within 6 days for 99% of customers

* These figures are calculated from when a customer has an account number and can pay into the account to the point when the service is received.

How quickly do customers get internet banking?* & **

Once an account is open, customers have internet banking:

the same day, for **0%** of customers;

on average, in **8** days; and

within **8** days for 99% of customers

* These figures are calculated from when a customer has an account number and can pay into the account to the point when the service is received.

** Internet Banking is when you can access all the services to enable you to set up payees and make payments which requires a card reader for additional payment security. When you first log-in to Internet Banking, you can undertake some activities including viewing account balances, transferring money between your own accounts, initiate some payments to a list of preferred suppliers and download statements. Our 8 day average figure is based on our full Internet Banking service and is dependent on you holding a working account number and requesting a card reader on the same day that you have registered for Internet Banking.

How quickly is an overdraft available?*

Once an account is open, the overdraft is available:

the same day, for **100%** of customers;

on average, in **0** days; and

within **0** days for 99% of customers

* These figures are calculated from when a customer has an account number and can pay into the account to the point when the service is received.

Replacing a debit card

How quickly do we replace debit cards that have been lost, stolen or stopped?

the same day, for **0%** of customers;

on average, in **4** days; and

within **16** days for 99% of customers
